“Waterloo Village – the Future of a Historic Gem”

Join us for an exciting presentation by Andrea L. Proctor, the Resource Interpretive Specialist for the Waterloo Village Historic Complex. Her topic will be “Waterloo Village – the Future of a Historic Gem”. The program Andrea will be speaking about will address the combined efforts of the State Division of Parks, the Friends of Waterloo Village and the Canal Society of New Jersey to clean up, restore and reopen buildings in the village and make the public aware of what a historic gem we have in our front yard.

Andrea, who has been in charge of the Waterloo Village site since 2013, oversees operations of the site’s administrative and interpretive services to ensure protection of the natural, historic and cultural resources, balanced with safe recreational and educational use by the visiting public. Andrea is also responsible for developing and overseeing the interpretive programs and approximately twenty seasonal staff at the site. She offers public workshops, presentations, and outreach programs and also develops and provides staff training for all part-time educators.
